I have not completed my B.Sc. Can I apply for the Master GEOSPHERES?

Yes, you can apply for the GEOSPHERES Master's program even if you have not yet completed your Bachelor's degree, under certain conditions.

According to §4 (4) of the [program regulations](#), you may be granted conditional admission if you meet the following criteria:

You must already have:

- At least 150 ECTS credits completed in your Bachelor's program (or equivalent achievements if your program is not ECTS-based).
- Proof of the required subject-specific competencies:
 - 10 ECTS in GIS, Geoinformatics, and/or Remote Sensing
 - 10 ECTS in Quantitative Methods, such as statistics, mathematics, geoscientific modeling, or natural science lab techniques
 - 10 ECTS in Physical Geography, including areas like geomorphology, soil geography, climatology, geoarchaeology, or related fields such as geology, mineralogy, meteorology, or Earth observation
- Proof of English language proficiency.

The M.Sc. GEOSPHERES is in English. Which kind of English language proficiency is needed?

At least B2 level (CEFR), proven by one of the following:

- TOEFL (min. 72 iBT)
- IELTS (min. 6.0)
- Cambridge FCE
- Equivalent school-leaving certificate or university coursework in English

Does the internship have to be in English?

No, it can be conducted in any language. However, the report on your training must be written in English.

Does the Subsidiary subject-specific development have to be in English?

No, it can be conducted in any language. Selections can be made from a large variety of courses offered by the Institute of Geography and Geology and the JMU Würzburg.
